Ursuline High School SCHOLARSHIP CHECKLIST

AVAILABLE TO QUALIFIED STUDENTS IN GRADES 10 THROUGH 12

The following 2 scholarships are **NEED BASED** (FAIR online application also required)

- Dewey and Irene Baldocchi Memorial Scholarship** *Criteria:* Student demonstrates strong commitment to education with a grade point average of at least 3.0; student holds Catholic education in high regard; student demonstrates valuing service to others.
- Inamay Larkin Scholarship** *Criteria:* Student must have a documented learning challenge i.e. hearing, speech or visual impairment, respiratory problems, learning disabilities etc. Written verification from a qualified professional must be on file with the Ursuline Counseling Office and will be kept in confidence in accordance with privacy laws.

The following scholarships are **NON-NEED BASED** (FAIR application is not required)

- Asian Scholarship** *Criteria:* Student must be at least one half Asian descent and maintain a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0.
- Carniglia Family Scholarship** *Criteria:* Student must be a St. Rose Elementary School graduate. Student must also have a 2.0 grade point or better in all math classes taken while a UHS student.
- Felciano Family Scholarship** *Criteria:* Student must be at least one half Hispanic descent and have maintained a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0.
- Jack Shea Memorial Scholarship** *Criteria:* Student should have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or better and must be involved in service to the school and/or the community. An interest in a career in law is preferred but not required.
- Louis and Alice Moratto Memorial Scholarship** *Criteria:* Student is actively involved in service to Ursuline High School.
- Mabel and Carlton Spridgen Memorial Scholarship** *Criteria:* Student has maintained a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better and is actively involved in service to Ursuline High School.
- Mary Lynch Scholarship** *Criteria:* Student must be a freshman who is requesting additional help to improve her understanding of Math and/or Science.

- Mary Paige Phillips Memorial Scholarship** *Criteria:* Student has maintained a 2.0 or better cumulative grade point average and is actively involved in service to the school and/or in ministry. Student involvement in music is preferred but not required.
- Sara Russell memorial Scholarship** *Criteria:* Student has maintained a 2.5 or better cumulative grade point average and has an interest in the arts.
- Sister Mary Peter Dresser Memorial Scholarship** *Criteria:* Student should have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better and be involved in service to the school and/or community. Demonstrated value for a particular course of study or in an extra curricular area must be described.
- Sister School Scholarship** *Criteria:* Student must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better and have demonstrated dedication/involvement in the area of cultural diversity.
- Sister Ursula Caster Memorial Scholarship** *Criteria:* Student must be a St. Rose Elementary School graduate. Student must also have a 2.0 grade point or better in all math classes taken while a UHS student.
- Ursuline Alumnae Scholarship** *Criteria:* If you are the daughter or granddaughter of a Santa Rosa Ursuline High School Alumna, this scholarship is available. A [*separate application*](#) for this scholarship is needed and can be obtained in the Finance Office.
